## Kitchen Temporarily Closing

It is with a heavy heart and yet at the same time excitement for the future of Maumee-BG Elks, that the Board has decided to close the Elks kitchen. This is effective immediately (September 20, 2021). The closing of the kitchen was not an easy decision for the board to make. The current board and past boards have worked diligently with the kitchen staff, trying to manage food cost and quality. Ten months ago when this board came together we had an agenda, first was the HVAC and roof, and the second was to work with the kitchen making it accountable for both quality of the food and to have a zero loss. Around two months ago, the board came to the decision that we would have to look at other avenues for the kitchen. This was not an easy process nor hasty.

With that, it is with great excitement that Shamy's Catering will take over the food operations for the lodge. This transition will take place over the next month giving Shamy's time to clean the kitchen getting it to their standards before re-opening. In addition, for Joe and his team to introduce themselves to our members finding out what you want on the menu.

During this closure, members may bring outside food into the lodge or have it delivered. Bar service will stay the same as it is currently and so will nights that we have wait staff.

If you are interested in helping with the transformation of the kitchen, we are looking for volunteers to help expedite this process to get us back to having food sooner than currently anticipated. Thanks in advance for your understanding and cooperation.

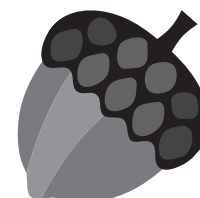
